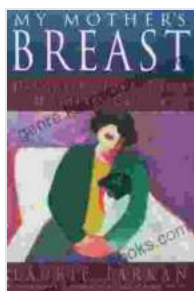


# Daughters Face Their Mothers Cancer: A Journey of Love, Loss, and Hope

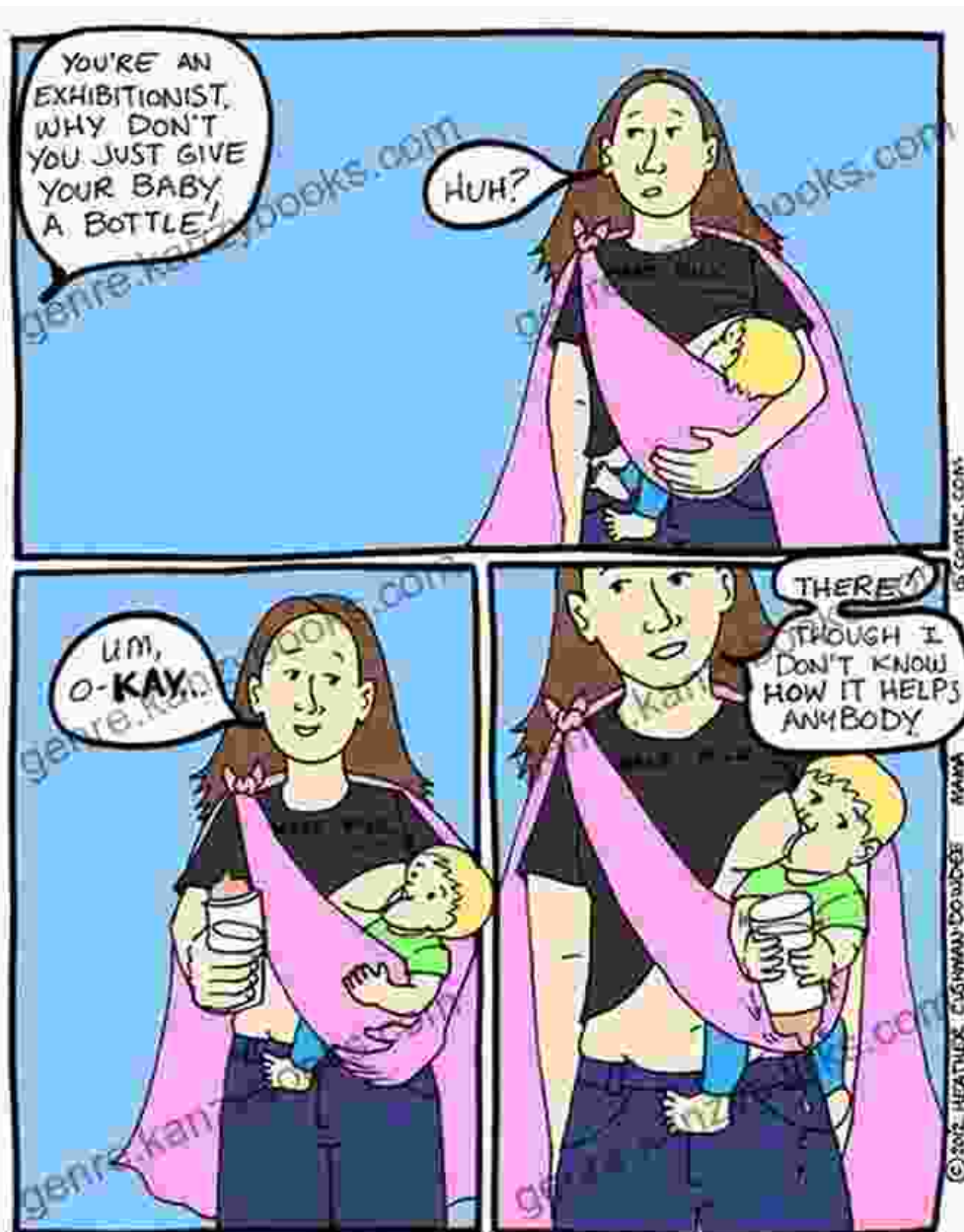

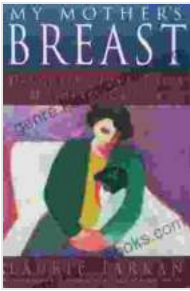
